

Public Access Statement for All Saints' Church, Cottenham

All Saints' Church is open to all. We welcome everyone to our church buildings.

The church building is physically open during daylight hours all year round, as well as holding regular services. It is also open by arrangement for concerts, events and services in the evenings or early mornings. We have a hearing loop. The church building is currently undergoing renovations to improve its value to the wider community and ensure better accessibility for people with disabilities. During this building work for safety reasons the church building will not be open.

The church hall is open by arrangement. Many community groups hire the church hall for meetings and activities, and it is also hired by individuals for private functions. When there is a service or event in the church, the hall is open for use of the facilities (such as toilets). The church hall is accessible for those in wheelchairs through the use of double-opening doors and a disabled access toilet.

There is limited dedicated parking near the church and church hall suitable for those with mobility requirements, with additional parking spaces made available for all during Sunday services.
