CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE

Junior Church runs during term-time with all aged 3yrs and upwards welcome. All leaders and helpers are safely recruited in line with our Safeguarding Policy. If you need communion brought to you where you sit, please tell the Welcome Team. If you do not receive communion, do come up for a blessing if you wish.

HALL DOOR MAINTENANCE From Monday 20th July work will take place to repair the rotten parts to the patio doors and windows of the church hall. This should last approximately 5 days. Disruption to the hall will be kept to a minimum but many of the groups have stopped now for the summer holidays.

UPDATE ON SERVERY AND WC INSTALLATION. Work continues at pace, but we have been advised that there will likely be a delay to the full completion until the middle of September. The main area affected is the gallery and new glass door into the ringing chamber. There is also some uncertainty in scheduling of the connection to the main sewer and necessary road closure. The next meeting with the contractors and architect will be held on Monday 20th, after which a clearer picture will emerge.
